

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

ENGLISH:

Four years including one semester of Expository Writing in Class V, one year of U.S. literature in Class VI, and one semester of Global Studies literature in Class VII.

FINE ARTS:

Two and a half years of fine arts (two semesters in Classes V/VI and one semester in Class VII or VIII).

HISTORY:

Two and a half years of history, completed by the end of Class VII (including one year of Modern World History in Class V, one year of U.S. History in Class VI and one semester of Global Studies history in Class VII).

LANGUAGE:

Three years of a language, completed by the end of Class VII.

MATHEMATICS:

Three years of mathematics, completed by the end of Class VII.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION:

Seven semesters of physical activity (two semesters each year in Classes V, VI and VII; one semester in fall of Class VIII).

HEALTH AND WELLNESS:

Three semesters of health and wellness (one semester each year in Classes V, VI and VII).

SCIENCE:

Two and a half years of science, completed by the end of Class VII.

SENIOR YEAR:

- One semester of a quantitative course in Class VIII; and
- Independent Learning Experience (second semester)
