



TRAFFIC & PARKING AT WINSOR

DROP OFF & PICK UP

103 Pilgrim Road

- All students must be dropped off and picked up at the main entrance to the school located at 103 Pilgrim Road.

375 Longwood Avenue

- Seniors with campus parking privileges will park, along with faculty and staff, in our Longwood Avenue lot (on the corner of Longwood and Brookline avenues). Seniors, with parking privileges, using the lot will be issued proximity (swipe) cards for access. These cards are assigned to the individual student and the student is responsible for all card usage.
- *No drop off or pick up will be allowed at the Longwood Avenue lot, or rear gate, at any time of the day or night. We also ask that you do not use the bus lane for pick up as this creates a dangerous situation.*

After-school

- There is no late bus to accommodate sports or other after-school activities. Students will be dismissed to the main entrance (103 Pilgrim Road) following all sports or other after-school activities.
- Pick up is available at the main entrance (103 Pilgrim Road).

LATE ARRIVAL & EARLY DISMISSAL

- For a late arrival, students **MUST** confirm their arrival with the Front Desk **BEFORE** going to class.
- For an early dismissal, a parent/caregiver **MUST** sign out and pick up students at the Front Desk **BEFORE** departing.

PARKING

- When coming to Winsor during school hours for meetings and/or events, we are unable to guarantee on-site parking. Unless instructed otherwise by your Winsor host, please go to the front parking lot at 103 Pilgrim Road. If space is not available there, you will be asked to seek alternative parking at the MASCO garage (375 Longwood Avenue) or one of the many nearby garages. We also encourage you to use public transportation.
- When parents attend **special class events or school-wide events** parking instructions will be sent out ahead of time in *Winsor Connects* and will be found on the on-line parent calendar. All parents/visitors must check in with security at the 103 entrance after they park. Please wear a nametag while on campus, and sign out before you leave.

SAFETY

- Never use a cell phone while driving through campus.
- Never make U-turns on Pilgrim Road or Short Street. They are one-way streets and will put you, students, and other drivers at risk of an accident.
- Drive **SLOWLY** on Pilgrim Road – no more than 10 mph.
